## GUIDANCE NOTES

### Disclosable Pecuniary Interests

In the above descriptions, the following words have the following meanings –

“*body in which the relevant person has a beneficial interest*” means a firm in which the relevant person is a partner or a body corporate of which the relevant person is a director, or in the securities of which the relevant person has a beneficial interest;

“*director*” includes a member of the committee of management of an industrial and provident society;

“*land*” excludes an easement, servitude, interest or right in or over land which does not carry with it a right for the relevant person (alone or jointly with another) to occupy the land or to receive income;

“*securities*” means shares, debentures, debenture stock, loan stock, bonds, units of a collective investment scheme within the meaning of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 and other securities of any description, other than money deposited with a building society.

### Other Registerable Personal Interests
